Work on the roads and utilities at the South campus has begun and should be completed, the Lord willing, by the end of September.

The new roundabout at 70th and Yankee Hill is complete as of this morning. However, don't get too excited, there are more roundabouts planned for Yankee Hill between 48th and Highway 2!

We have received \$1,125,747 toward the expansion so far, with pledges and expectations approaching \$3.5 million. The \$2.22 million loan has been paid down to \$1,867,000 thanks to the generosity of over 460 families in the first 8 months of Participate 4 Growth.

No specific calendar has been set for construction, but we will likely establish a building development committee for the South campus relatively soon. Completion of the first phase could take up to 2 years.
